It has been satisfying to be among the cohort of researchers who have studied the legal system, especially trial juries, from a psychological perspective. I believe we have learned much that would be useful if the system were to be revised. If the system were to be revised" . . . there's the rub. Like other social scientists, I believed—perhaps arrogantly—that the results of our research efforts could be used to make trial juries operate with more efficiency, accuracy, and satisfaction. Over the last two decades, much knowledge has accumulated. How can we put this knowledge to work? Judges are the gatekeepers of the legal system.
